When he peers over his 100-year-old spectacles with his blue, crinkled eyes and says, “Be good. I’m Watching,” he leaves no doubt that there is a Santa Claus. If you’ve been good he may give you a giant 1 oz. candy cane and when you get home you may find that Santa dusted you with silver glitter.
